Testimony w/out Document Review¹

During the Banking Inquiry, there was a practice adopted whereby witnesses would be called to give testimony when the documentation pertaining to the particular witnesses would not yet have been reviewed by any experts or even delivered.

To quote Mr Justice Senan Allen's response to me and to this concern (that a number of experts including me had in respect of key evidential deficits); "I can easily see that the Inquiry was under resourced. I can easily see that the deadlines were impossible.

I understand your point entirely that how can you call your witnesses first and do your discovery later - I mean, to a lawyer it seems crazy".

These views in which he agreed with me wholeheartedly did not find their way into his fabricated report, as it did not uphold the predetermined narrative.

Core books of evidence for key witnesses were closed before large swathes of evidence had been read & analysed or in fact even been delivered.

On redactions, Mr Justice Allen agrees with me too: "Believe it or not, nobody disagrees that you had a point in relation to redactions".

Then refers to my "over focus" when at that stage only 27 documents out of 7000 were permitted to be challenged.²
