**Re: Clarification Regarding Prior Correspondence to Xxxxxxx LLP and
Recent Judicial Listing Concerning Credit Servicer Litigation**

Dear Mr Justice xxxxx,

In recent years we have been researching various cases of banking and other frauds in Ireland in preparation for an upcoming documentary. The initial emphasis was on the Banking Inquiry cover up and the intense retaliation by the State against the Banking Inquiry whistleblower, but as you review our website, you will note that our research has expanded to include other matters of grave concern in Ireland related to corporate governance.

As we progress our research, your name has arisen as someone likely to be interested in the information that we have gathered - prepared by others and shared with us and note that further to my correspondence of December 7, December 17, 2025, and December 22, 2025 directed to Mr xxxx xxxxx, Managing Partner, Xxxxxxx LLP, several matters raised therein remain unresolved.

Most notably, Xxxxxxx has offered no confirmation as to whether you retain any form of financial, beneficial or residual interest in that firm since your elevation to the High Court. In the circumstances and in light of your publicly stated reassignment to the Wards of Court list on 18 December 2025 and your indication that you would no longer be presiding over credit servicer-related litigation, it is a matter of concern that your name has now reappeared on the published list for tomorrow, assigned to a case in which Start Mortgages DAC appears as a party – Court 9 at 11:00am.

This development reinforces the need for complete clarity regarding any potential conflicts or continuing associations that might reasonably be perceived to affect impartiality. There is also a wider growing concern that members of the Bar are continuing to rely upon judgments delivered in credit servicer-related cases over which you presided, notwithstanding these unresolved questions regarding the accuracy of representations made by such entities as to their legal standing. Where such judgments may have set precedents relied upon in ongoing litigation, the need for explicit clarification and if necessary corrective measures is heightened.

Accordingly, I respectfully request your written reply to the following question:

Do you, or any member of your immediate family, hold any membership interest, profit share, or other financial stake in XXXXXXXX LLP, whether directly, indirectly, or through nominees?

If yes, please specify:

- (i) the exact nature and percentage of the interest held;
- (ii) the value of any distributions, payments, or entitlements received since elevation to the bench; and
- (iii) confirmation that such interest is not held through a blind trust, pension arrangement, or other vehicle over which neither you nor your immediate family retain control.

This information is sought in the public interest and for the purpose of ensuring transparency and confidence in the High Court's handling of proceedings involving credit servicers. It is likewise relevant to determining whether corrective review may be warranted in prior cases where standing representations were subsequently shown, or alleged, to have been false or materially misleading.

As part of our own research, we offer everyone the opportunity to respond to our questions in writing and simultaneously we offer everyone the opportunity to go on camera. If you wish to go on camera, we will provide your name to the documentary team and any final decision will rest with them.
