**RE: Mr [REDACTED] – High Priority**

My name is Mr. [REDACTED] and I am a victim of coercive control, and domestic abuse. I am formally writing to you for urgent assistance and help. Please note, that I do so in the full belief and fear that I will face severe repercussions from An Garda Síochána for continuing to protect my interests on this most serious matter.

I would be remiss in not noting that a number of senior members of An Garda Síochána, to include Commissioner Drew Harris, were also copied in this email. I can confirm my email was first received and opened by an IP address geolocated in the United Kingdom at 5:40:45pm and later by an IP address geolocated at Garda Headquarters, Phoenix Park, Dublin at 5:46:36pm. I can further confirm that to date, only An Garda Síochána have received and responded to my communication.

I firmly state that the complaint in question is a civilian issue. I say the perpetrator is a rank-and-file member of An Garda Síochána, who has not, at any stage, committed the offences in her capacity as a member of An Garda Síochána.

I say that I have previously attempted to bring all aspects of this criminal behaviour to the attention of An Garda Síochána and the Courts Service (to include four district court judges), where I have not been tolerated nor afforded assistance or support. To date, my plea for assistance has been repeatedly met with continued resistance, hostility and disregard.

I say that the Courts Service have advised me to liase with An Garda Síochána, and An Garda Síochána have advised me to continue to liase with the Courts Service, in a clear and deliberate effort to frustrate the course of justice. I furthermore state that I am in receipt of technical evidence that the Court Service have, on more than one occasion, shared ex-parte documents, electronically submitted by me, to third parties prior to related court hearings which, without fail, have resulted in unjust and unfavourable determinations.

I say that An Garda Síochána have been and continue to actively assist the perpetrator by refusing to investigate my formal complaint of Coercive Control. Strategically, I am being prevented from seeking assistance from any statutory bodies and/or higher offices, therefore denying me procedural fairness and a comprehensive assessment of my complaint by the Director of Public Prosecutions.

It must be noted that the attached documents are not and have not been before any Courts, i.e Family or Criminal, therefore they should not be dismissed on that basis.

As per my previous correspondence, I attach the following exhibits for your immediate attention:

I believe that my daughters and I are being gravely let down by the justice system and the State through the outright and continued failure/refusal of the Courts Service and An Garda Síochána to hold the perpetrator accountable for any of her criminal behaviour.

This dismissal and failure has not only supported, but is now encouraging and exacerbating the relentless and ongoing behaviour.

I say that since I communicated with An Garda Síochána in October 2021 and in particular, the 9th November 2021, I continue to be monitored, harassed and intimidated. I have had my employment terminated due to copies of court papers being anonymously issued to my employers, and I have more recently become homeless as I can no longer afford to pay rent.

I hereby formally request a meeting with your office and appeal for your assistance as Minister for Justice. I desperately plead with you to consider the alarming content of the attached documents, with a view to resolving the frightening escalated criminal matters involving Garda-IRA collusion and intimidation, alleged threat-to-kill, unlawful Garda monitoring and the concerted effort by the justice system to prevent me seeking help.

I wish to thank you for your time and anxiously await your response.
